The June 2007 issue of the IMFlash marks the beginning of a new generation of our newsletter, offering a fresh new look and new automated subscription system.

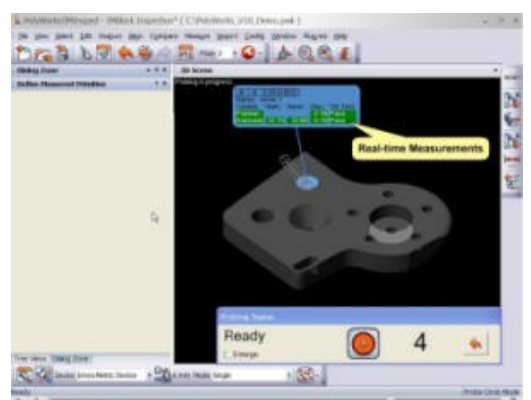
Our previous newsletter system limited us to register only one contact per company. Some of your colleagues might have missed receiving the newsletter because of this limitation.
